From 2021 to 2025, he held the position of Legal Counsel within the Internal Audit Department of Türkerler Holding and, concurrently, assumed responsibilities as Chief Legal Counsel, Executive Committee Member, and Member of the Board of Directors at group companies operating in the energy sector.
